In this final week of Advent, we stand very close to Christmas. The waiting is almost over. The world feels busy and noisy, yet Advent invites us to slow down and to notice what really matters. Pope Francis often reminded us that caring for our planet is not an extra task, it's part of our faith. The earth is our common home, given to us by God as a gift. Like any gift, it is meant to be loved, protected, and shared.

In the Gospel this week, we see Mary preparing to welcome Jesus. She does not rush. She listens. She trusts. She makes space in her life for God to grow. Mary teaches us how to wait with hope and care. She shows us that love begins with attention.

This week, let's wait like Mary, quietly, lovingly, and with trust, so that when Christ comes, he finds not only open hearts, but our beautiful world being gently cared for.
